

Canine Senior Wellness Visit Check List

- Bring stool sample
 - Companion Animal Parasite Council recommends annual testing
 - Samples can be placed in any clean container or baggie or a pre-paid fecal collection container can be picked up at the clinic
 - Stool sample needs to be collected within 12 hours of the appointment
- Bring urine sample
 - Urinalysis is included in the Senior Screen
 - To collect a urine sample, place a clean container under your dog as he/she urinates. Sample needs to be collected within 4-6 hours of the appointment and stored in the refrigerator
 - Urine collection kits can also be picked up at the clinic
- Bring any/all medications that your pet is currently taking
 - This includes over the counter and prescription medications (including heartworm/flea preventatives)
- Bring a list of any questions or concerns you may have regarding your pet's health
- Fill out enclosed Senior Questionnaire and bring with you to appointment. These questions are very important in order for us to understand and help improve your dog's quality of care.
- If you are planning on having the Senior Screen performed, it is recommended that your dog be fasted for 8 hours.
